LOCAL RULES

- OUT OF BOUNDS: Over the walls, fences or wires bounding the course and beyond the line of white posts to the right of the 8th and running from the back of the 1st tee to the top end of the car park. Also, on or over the rockery and beyond the walls and paths surrounding the 1st tee (Rules 18.2 and 18.2b).
- ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (ACC): If an ACC interferes with your stance or swing, relief may be obtained under Rule 16 by dropping the ball at the nearest point of complete relief no nearer the hole.

The following are ACC: Animal Hole, Immoveable Obstructions, Ground Under Repair or Temporary Water (Rules 16.1a & 16.1b). Also covers Embedded ball (Rule 16.3a).

- a. Immoveable Obstructions on the course include direction posts, man-made paths, service roads and their board edgings and fixed sprinkler heads (Rule 16.1a).
- LOOSE IMPEDIMENTS: A ball lying in a gathering of loosely mown grass, tractor or wheel marks, may be lifted, cleaned, and dropped without penalty in the nearest relief area no nearer the hole (Rule 16).
- 4. OLD HOLES: When the ball lies on the Putting Green, if any old hole interferes with the line of putt, the ball may be lifted and placed, without penalty, as near as possible to where it lay, but not nearer the hole, to avoid putting over the old hole.
- 5. PENALTY AREAS: Yellow stakes or lines and red stakes or lines (Rule 17).
- 6. STONES IN BUNKERS: Stones in Bunkers are Loose Impediments (Rule 12.2a). See rule 15.1 for procedure.
- NO PLAY ZONES (NPZ): If your ball lies in a NPZ relief MUST be taken under Rule 16.1b (and 16.1f).
- 8. STAKED TREES: There is no free relief from staked trees. Relief may be taken under unplayable ball rule (Rule 19.1). Where saplings or bushes less than one club in height interfere with stance or swing the ball may be lifted and dropped without penalty at the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole.
