- ### LOCAL RULES
1. One of boundaries: Over the water, fences or wires bounding the course and beyond the line of white posts to the right of the 9th, 9th and 17th bunkers and running from the back of the 1st tee to the left end of the car park. Also on or over the 12th and 17th bunkers and running from the back of the 1st tee to the left end of the car park.
 2. **ARBITRARY COURSE CONDITIONS (ACC)**: If an ACC interferes with your stance or swing, you may be allowed under Rule 16. By dropping the ball at the nearest point of complete relief you may leave the hole. The following are ACC: Animal holes, unavoidable obstructions, Ground Under Repair or Temporary Water. Rule 16.1a & 1b also covers Embedded Ball Rule 16.3a.
 - * Unavoidable obstructions on the course include but not only direction posts, man made paths and stone walls and their board edges, but also gates, walls or wheel marks - may be lifted, cleaned and dropped.
 - 3. A Ball Lying in loose material (loose impediment, sand or wheel marks) - may be lifted, cleaned and dropped without penalty in the nearest relief area. Rule 16.
 - 4. When the ball lies on the putting green, if any old hole markers with the line of the put, you may repair a hole 13 to 14.
 - 5. **Penalty areas** - Yellow areas or tees - that tees or areas. Rule 17.
 - 6. **Boundaries in bunkers** are loose impediments - Rule 12.2a, see rule 13 for procedure.
 - 7. **NO FLAG ZONES (NZ)**: If your ball lies in a NZ, you MUST be taken under Rule 16.1b (16.1b, NZ2) outside the hole by the side of the NZ. You may lift your ball, flag or bushes less than one club length in height which may interfere with your stance or swing - No penalty.
 - 8. **No flag relief from raised tees**: Relief may be taken under unplayable ball Rule 19.1.
 - 9. **LOST BALL** - Search time 3 minutes. If it is known or virtually known that a penalty area, relief may be taken under rule 17.1b for one penalty stroke.
 - 10. **Lost Ball** - If lost under rule 17.1b, you may take relief under rule 16.1b for one penalty stroke. This rule is B.
